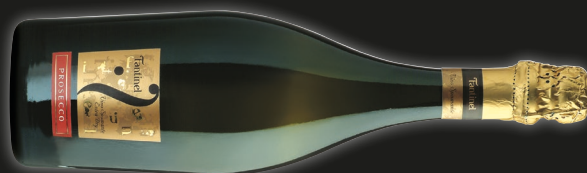




## *Wine Dinner*



### Fantinel Prosecco Extra Dry, Italy

Fresh, dry and fruity, a pleasant and extremely elegant bouquet with delightful, floral hints.



### Soave Classico, Bolla, Italy

Bouquet of apricot and pepper, dry yet with soft acidity and a creamy almond palate, a blending of the highly prized Trebbiano di Soave grape.



### Vidal Riesling, Marlborough, New Zealand

A fine example of the Riesling grape, showing lime and floral aromas combined with the minerality and citrus fruit flavours typical of the grape in an off-dry, 'New World' style.



### Beaujolais-Villages Combe aux Jacques, Louis Jadot, France

Expressive Beaujolais with bright cherry and spice. Lots of juicy fruit with a soft smooth finish.



### Flagstone Dragon Tree Cabernet Sauvignon-Shiraz-Pinotage Western Cape, South Africa

Wonderful rich, concentrated red with bright blackcurrant and mint aromas. Delicious concentrated black fruit with a whisper of vanilla oak and minty spice.

## FANTINEL

Fantinel is based in the sleepy town of Spilimbergo in the heart of the Friuli region. Surrounded by the eastern 'arm' of the Alps on gravel-rich soils, this family-owned winery was established in 1969 by Mario 'Paron' Fantinel. Mario wanted to build on his reputation as a noted hotelier and restaurateur by also becoming a producer of fine wines from his native region of north-east Italy.

## BOLLA

Bolla was Founded by restaurateur Abele Bolla in Veneto, north east Italy. Wishing to offer his restaurant customers a superior experience Abele decided to make and sell his own wine, a Soave, in 1883, initially a passion that unfolded to become a worldwide brand. The Company passed from father to son for many generations and the ethos is to preserve the original values and philosophies created almost 130 years ago.

## VIDAL

With a passion to pursue winemaking in his adopted country, Spaniard Anthony Joseph Vidal purchased a Hawkes Bay racing stable in 1905, converted it into a wine cellar, planted vines and established himself as one of New Zealand's early wine innovators. From these pioneering beginnings, Vidal has gone on to create highly acclaimed wines from one century to the next. The passion that created Vidal over 100 years ago burns just as brightly today, represented by the eternal flame adorning each bottle of Vidal wine.

## LOUIS JADOT

Louis Jadot has been making fine wines for over 150 years. Such history has provided them with a wealth of experience so it is no surprise that they are today, one of the most highly regarded and consistent top Burgundy houses. Over the years Louis Jadot has sourced the best from Burgundy growers. In addition they have built up their own vineyard base which now stands at 150 hectares – a considerable vineyard holding for any Burgundy house. This combination gives them control over the quality of the fruit they use, to make what they believe to be the best wine which reflects the individual 'terroirs'. All their wines are made under the watchful eye of Jacques Lardière
